ORDINANCE NO. 19-05

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE PARKING OF CERTAIN VEHICLES IN THE PARKWAY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF FOREST VIEW, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS, IN THE EXERCISE OF THE VILLAGE'S HOME RULE POWERS, as follows:

SECTION 1: Amendment. Section 9-2-3 of the Forest View Village Code, "Stopping, Standing or Parking Prohibited in Specified Place," is hereby amended by adding the following Subsection (E), "Recreational Vehicle Parking Regulations" as represented by underlined bold type:

(E) Recreational Vehicle Parking Regulations

No recreational vehicle, including camping, trailer, motor home, mini motor home, travel trailer, truck camper, van camper or boats may be parked on either a paved or unpaved surface on any Village parkway in a residential zoning district.

SECTION 2: Home Rule. This Ordinance and each of its terms shall be the effective legislative act of a home rule municipality without regard to whether such ordinance should (a) contain terms contrary to the provisions of current or subsequent non-preemptive state law, or (b) legislate in a manner or regarding a matter not delegated to municipalities by state law. It is the intent of the corporate authorities of the Village of Forest View that to the extent that the terms of this Ordinance should be inconsistent with any non-preemptive state law, that this Ordinance shall

supersede state law in that regard within its jurisdiction.

SECTION 3: Full Force and Effect. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval, and shall subsequently be published in pamphlet form as provided by law.
